Predictions of Betrayal and Denial

John 13:18–38 May 1, 2016 **Dr. Mark Strauss**

Theme: The Last Supper narrative continues and Jesus predicts both Judas's betrayal and Peter's denial. Those closest to Jesus, who have shared closest fellowship with Him, will let Him down. Yet Jesus will remain faithful to the task God has given Him.
