The Burial, Empty Tomb & Appearance to Mary Magdalene

John 19:38–10:18

July 10, 2016

Theme: The Gospel of John reaches its climax with the discovery of the empty tomb on Sunday morning by Mary Magdalene. Peter and John rush to the tomb and find it empty with the grave clothes in place. Jesus then appears to Mary Magdalene, confirming His victory over death. Mary becomes the first to announce the resurrection. He is risen indeed!
