Jesus Sentenced to be Crucified John 19:1-16 June 26, 2016 Pastor Ken Ingold

Theme: Jesus is sentenced to be crucified. It is easy to blame the Jews, especially Caiaphas, or to blame Pilate, as, at least from his perspective, he had the authority and the power to decide Jesus' fate. But the truth is this...it was God's plan before the foundations of the earth in order that we might be redeemed through the blood of Christ. If we are going to blame anyone...blame ourselves. We're the guilty ones in need of a Savior.
